



John McEnhill Legacy Scholarship
Presented by Floyd County Chamber of Commerce

One non-renewable scholarship award of \$1,000 is available to a Floyd County graduating senior who is altruistically minded, demonstrates highly promising leadership and community involvement. This scholarship can be used for pursuing an undergraduate degree or fees associated with a reputable program that provides leadership development and/or community service training program.

This scholarship is to support students with a GPA of 2.5 and above who desire to bring their talents, abilities, and skills back to Floyd County and enhance our community through involvement and volunteerism.

Chamber Mission:

The mission of the Floyd County Chamber of Commerce is to support local and regional businesses with networking opportunities, informative and educational resources and to serve as an advocate for our members and our community. The Chamber is a non-profit, non-partisan, and non-political organization.

Essay Guidelines:

The application and essay should reflect: *“How is giving back to your community important to you now and in the future?”*

The John McEnhill Legacy scholarship will be awarded based on the quality of the essay, community involvement and/or volunteer roles, letter(s) of reference from an organization in which the student volunteered, and a completed application. The Floyd County Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Committee will make a final decision on the recipient.

The award will be a check for \$1,000 to be used for tuition, equipment, or any other educational need, paid to the accepting college, university, or eligible program.

Application and Scholarship Requirements:

Application and essay must be submitted **by Monday, March 13th**. Applications may be submitted online by visiting www.Floydchamber.org; or hard copies delivered to the High School Guidance Office, or the Floyd County Chamber of Commerce.

1. Funds must be requested by the university or college during the 2023-2024 school year.
2. A written request must be submitted to extend the funds to another school year. This request must be submitted to the Chamber office by December 31, 2023.
3. Ensure all required items below are completed before submitting the application.
