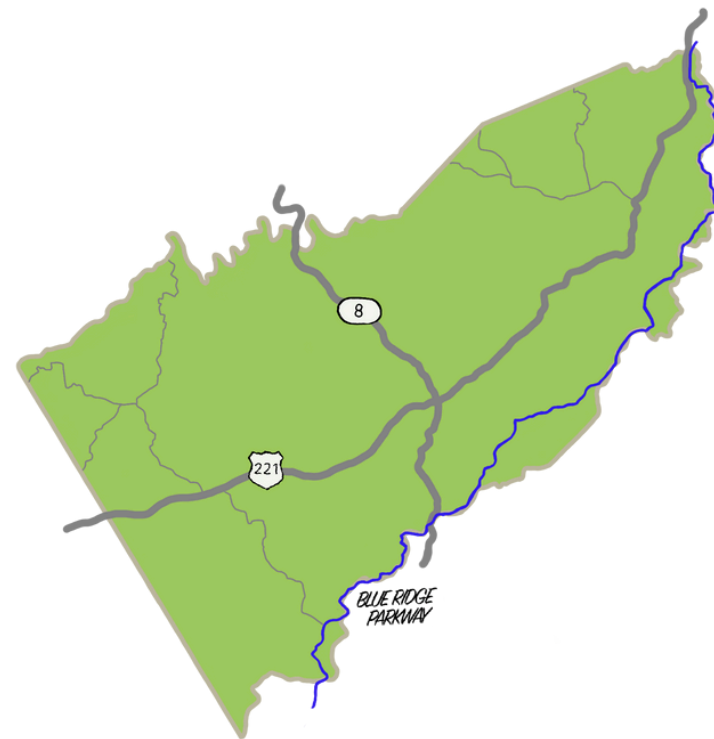

HISTORY THAT RUNS DEEP

Nestled in the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains, Floyd boasts a rich history waiting to be uncovered. Curtis Turner - Racing Legend

GUIDED TOURS IN FLOYD

The Blue Ridge Parkway

The Blue Ridge Parkway is a scenic roadway that winds its way through the heart of the Blue Ridge Mountains, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding landscape. As one of America's most iconic drives, it stretches across 469 miles, connecting Shenandoah National Park in Virginia to Great Smoky Mountains National Park in North Carolina. In Floyd, VA, the Parkway provides easy access to stunning overlooks, hiking trails, and opportunities for outdoor recreation. Visitors can enjoy leisurely drives along its winding paths, stopping at overlooks to take in panoramic views of the mountains and valleys below. With its abundance of natural beauty and recreational



opportunities, the Blue Ridge Parkway is a must-visit destination for travelers exploring Floyd and the surrounding area.

Floyd Historical Walking Tour - Covering 1.8 miles, this tour features 45 historic places around the Floyd Historic District. It showcases the community's creativity, ingenuity, craftsmanship, and pride in constructing buildings before access to major infrastructure.

Standing Water-Powered Mills of Floyd County - This self-driving tour includes brief descriptions, addresses, and driving directions for 13 of Floyd's historic water-powered mills.

Tracing Our Roots: A Tour of Laurel Branch Road - Uncover centuries-old history and fascinating stories of the families who laid down roots nestled along this self-driving tour.

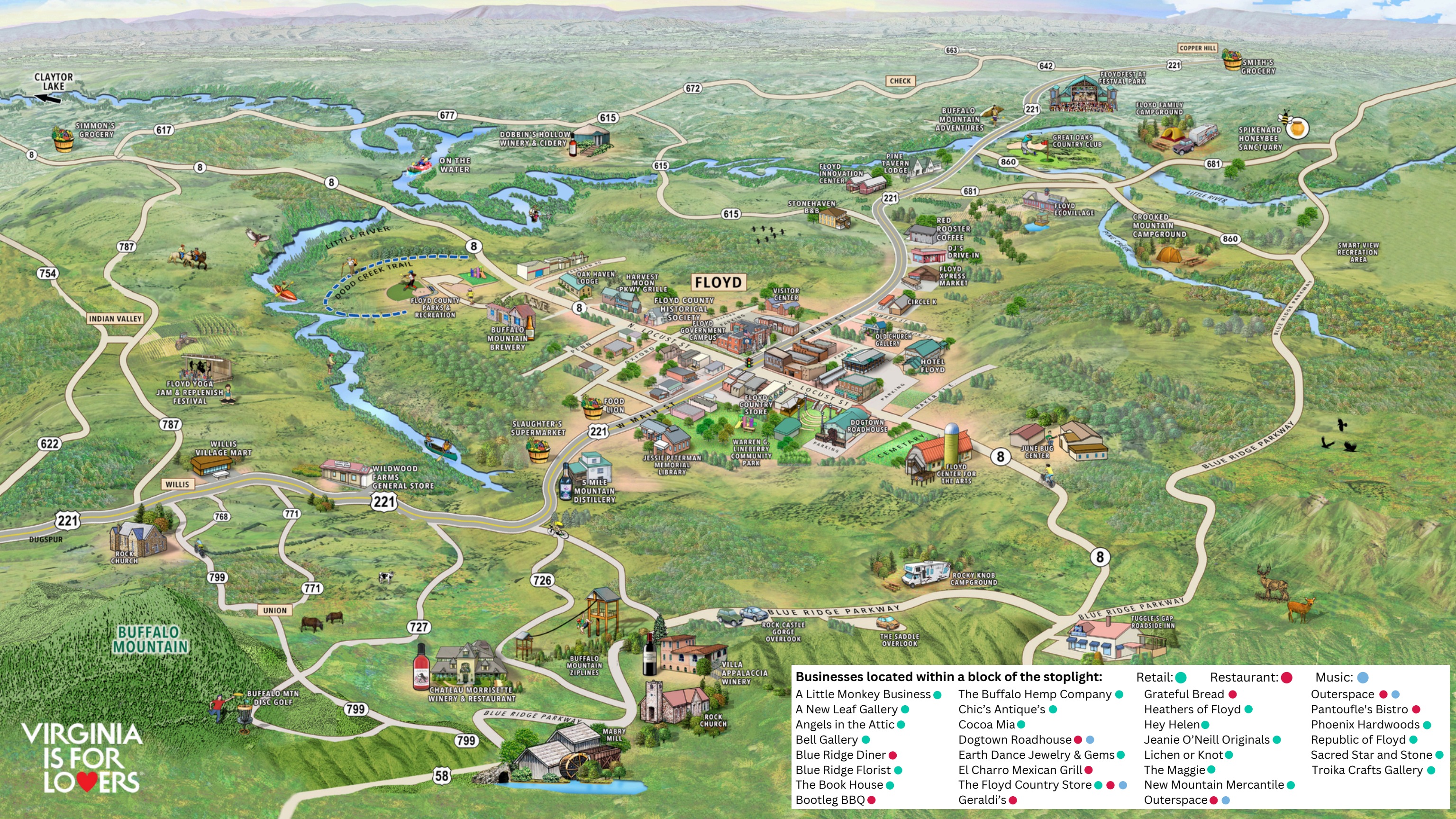

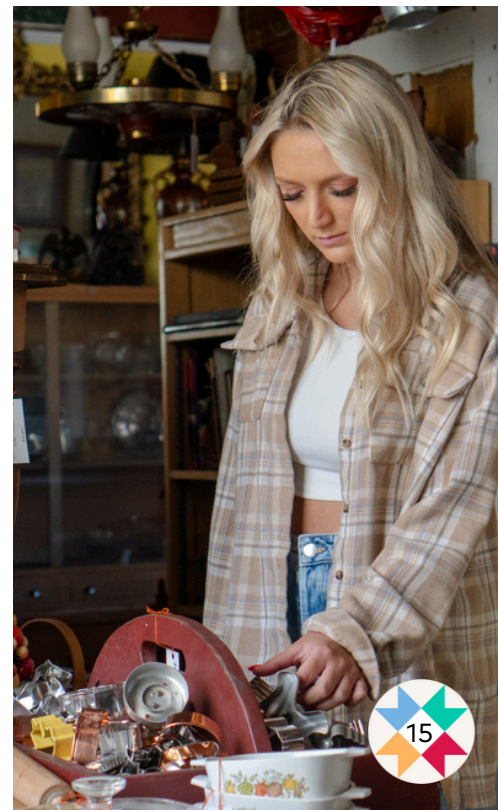

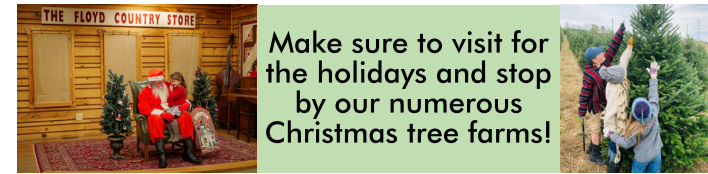
